



Senior Uniform Guidelines

Daily Uniform

All clothing items should reflect good taste and modest fit. All pants, capris, shorts, skirts, and skorts to be worn at the waist or slightly below. Seniors have the privilege of wearing business/business casual attire., except when Formal Uniforms are required: On Wednesdays for chapel and events requiring Formal Uniform, Seniors must wear business attire. Beginning with the 2020-21 school year, students in Class of 2021 and beyond will be required to wear the Formal Uniform that all other students are required to wear. Any requests for modification to uniform requirements must be approved in advance by the Head of school, Division Director or Dean of Student Affairs.

Girls

- **Shirt** with or without collar, with sleeves, free of writing and long enough to cover the torso at all times. Shirts are not to be see-through and no visible undergarments. Tank tops, spaghetti straps, or halter tops are not allowed. Shirts/Blouses that expose the shoulders/back area are not allowed.
- **Dresses, pants, capris, shorts, or skirts**— all dresses, shorts, skirts, will be within three inches of the knee. Length requirements also apply to top of slit in skirts or dresses with a slit. Pants that are not allowed: cargo, riding, and sweats. Yoga/leggings may only be worn as an undergarment.
- **Hair** - Should be neat, clean, well-groomed, of a natural color, and should be styled out of the face with simple, complimentary accessories. Hair accessories must be red, navy, white, or black.
- **Accessories** - Unobtrusive earrings, necklaces and bracelets that are complimentary to the uniform can be worn. Body piercing and visible tattoos are unacceptable.
- **Shoes** - Closed-heel shoes (flat or heel less than 3" heel)

Boys

- **Shirt** - Collared shirts, tucked in, free of writing
- **Pants/Shorts** - Twill, chino, or poplin dress pants or knee-length shorts with leather or canvas belt. No Cargo pants/shorts.
- **Shoes** - Sneakers or flat closed-toe and closed-heel shoes in black, brown, or navy.
- **Hair** - should be neat, clean, well-groomed, of a natural color and style, and should not obscure facial features or extend below the collar. Faces should be clean-shaven.
- **Accessories** - No earrings may be worn. Body piercing and visible tattoos are unacceptable.

Formal Uniform

For Class of 2020 ONLY

Seniors have the privilege of wearing business attire as Formal Uniform. However, this privilege may be revoked individually or collectively should the administrative staff determine students are not demonstrating "good taste" in his/her/their choice(s) of attire and presenting themselves in a manner consistent with Mead Hall Episcopal School's expectations.

Formal Uniform

Effective 2020-21 school year

Girls

- **Cardigan** - (October-March) Navy, fine-gauge, cotton cardigan with logo and no pockets
- **Skirt/Skort** - Plaid A-line or pleated, no more than 3" above the knee. Skort style must be with skirt in front and back.
- **Shirt** - Solid white, long-sleeve, three-quarter sleeve, or short-sleeve, collared dress shirt
- **Socks/Tights** - Socks are optional. Solid white or navy tights or knee-high socks; no anklets (nude hose optional)
- **Shoes** - Flat, closed-toe and closed-heel shoes; black, brown, or navy leather dress shoes

Boys

- **Blazer** - (October-March) Solid navy with no adornments
- **Pants** - Khaki (no shorts)
- **Shirt** - Solid white, long-sleeve or short-sleeve, collared dress shirt
- **Tie** - Mead Hall ties or bowties (available in Mead Hall Episcopal School's Store only)
- **Belt** - Black or brown leather dress belt
- **Socks** - Solid black, brown, navy, or khaki
- **Shoes** - Black or brown leather dress shoes
