



# 6th Grade School Summer Reading

To be prepared for the start of the new academic year, you are required to complete summer reading. You will need to purchase the book, download to an electronic device, or borrow from the local library.

Our choice this summer is *Holes* by Louis Sachar. If you have already read *Holes*, you may choose another novel that is grade level appropriate.

You should come to school ready to complete an assignment based on the novel you read. This will be your first graded assignment as a 6th grader.

## Helpful Tips:

- Do not wait until the last minute to read.
- If you have your own copy book, make notes in it at the end of each chapter or underline/highlight passages you like. We will discuss these in August.
- If you borrow the book or have an electronic copy, take some handwritten notes.
- Notes are important so that you remember the characters and plot when it is time to complete the assignment in August.

**REMEMBER:** This is a **mandatory** reading assignment. We will be discussing your grade's novel, including its characters and major themes, during the first week of class as well. This shared reading experience will be a great way to start off the school year. Enjoy the summer break!
