NEW RECTOR ANNOUCEMENT

The Rev. Dr. Marshall A. Jolly has accepted the call to become the new Rector of St. Thaddeus Church. Marshall will celebrate his first services at St. Thaddeus on November 6, 2023. He has been serving as the rector of Grace Episcopal Church in Morganton, NC, since 2015. In addition to parish ministry, Marshall is a dedicated diocesan and community leader. He is married to Elizabeth Jolly, a Licensed Clinical Social Worker.

A native of Paris, Kentucky, Marshall is a cum laude graduate of Transylvania University, where he earned a BA in American Studies. Marshall is also a two-time graduate of Emory University's Candler School of Theology, where he earned a Master of Divinity and certificate in Anglican studies, as well as a Doctor of Ministry in Biblical interpretation and proclamation. His dissertation project examined the history and theology of the Daily Office and offered teaching resources for enhancing the practice of daily prayer in parishes throughout the Episcopal church.


