Dear Mead Hall Families!

We are excited to announce that **Priority Re-enrollment for our current Mead Hall families opens February 1, 2024** and will continue through February 29, 2024. Several families from outside of our Mead Hall community have toured our campuses and they are waiting to apply. Hence, if you are planning to secure a space for your child/children, we urge you to complete the re-enrollment paperwork by **February 29, 2024**.

If you are planning to enroll a new student who is a sibling of a current Mead Hall student, you will be able to apply (for the new student) beginning February 1, 2024. We are paying close attention to our enrollment numbers and once we've determined availability, we will begin offering admission to current families first and then to new families on or around Friday, March 15, 2024. Once we've reached our capacity for a specific grade, we will communicate that to you promptly.

We are glad to offer affordable tuition levels that are of excellent value for an independent school education in the CSRA. As you know, in comparison with peer schools, our tuition is the most all inclusive in the area with no additional required fees other than the annual registration fee. Discovering Tracks

My daughter sent me this link to a video of two children. You can watch it here: <u>LINK</u>. In the video, the children find some tracks carved into the pavement of their neighborhood street. The older child, based on her knowledge and experience of the world, labels what she sees as: "tire tracks" while the younger one's imagination leads her to say, "dinosaur tracks." The younger child then says, "follow him!" while the older child shakes her head, "no." The younger child runs off to seek the dinosaur.

In just a few seconds, this clip captures the essence of lower school life. We begin with small students who have unbounded imaginations and little understanding of the dangers that surround them. Adults surround these students, helping them stay safe while they explore and learn about the world. By the time students leave fourth grade, they have a strong knowledge base upon which they assess the world around them and make more thoughtful decisions which consider safety.

The whole process is a joy to experience - especially when the older students interact with the younger ones, which we do regularly through our book buddy program. This week fourth graders and PK students enjoyed "stone soup" together, an imaginary meal that becomes real when we learn to share.






Bowling


